



COMING OFF A GRAVEYARD SHIFT IN MARCH 2014, SAN DIEGO POLICE DEPARTMENT SWAT OFFICER PATRICK **KELLEY RECEIVED A CALL THAT SAVED**

A LIFE. Responding to a home in City Heights, he witnessed a shocking sight: a scared puppy, swollen, in pain, missing hair, covered in scabs and swarming flies. Kelley drew closer, bending down to offer the pup his hand for a gentle lick.

"My fiancée says he licked the right hand that day," reflects Kelley, who left the home but couldn't leave the image of the dog behind. He reached out to fellow animal lovers on the force, including Sergeant Sharon McFalls, who was instrumental in what happened next. The scared dog was removed from the home and taken to San Diego Humane Society for treatment. Out of curiosity, Kelley checked in on him, and curiosity quickly turned into care for the pit bull/bulldog, who suffered from staph infection and mange. He inquired about fostering the dog when he was healthy enough, and made the commitment to nurture him back to health

After four months of fostering, the dog, now named Richard, became an official member of the Kelley household. More than a year later, Kelley is amazed at how far Richard has come. "He's a tough little dog who's been through a lot," he says. "The coolest part is seeing him sleep in his bed, knowing where he came from and knowing that now he's safe."

IT ALL STARTED WITH AN AGING QUARTER HORSE NAMED CASPER. Now. 12 years later, Horses of Tir Na Nog serves as a sanctuary for more than 50 aging horses in San Diego's East County, where abused, abandoned, and neglected horses live out their lives in peace and tranquility.

Amy-Pat Rigney and Vanessa Malone founded Horses of Tir Na Nog in 2003, naming the sanctuary after an Irish myth of a land of youth, where no one ever grew old or sick. "Our intention was to serve the older horse population and provide a place where they get to just be horses," Rigney says. "Here, it doesn't matter how old our residents become.
